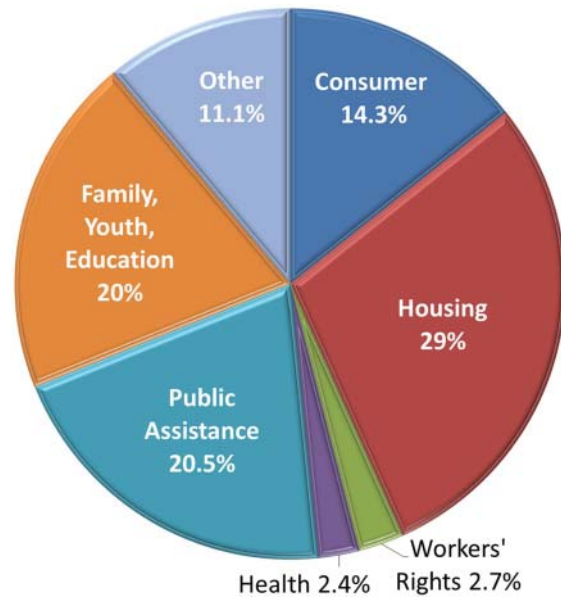


LEGAL SERVICES: BY THE NUMBERS

- 1,647 foreclosure defense cases were accepted
- 8,970 family cases were opened
- 1,685 cases on behalf of veterans, active-duty military, and members of the reserves

Legal rights publication downloads and legal rights video views

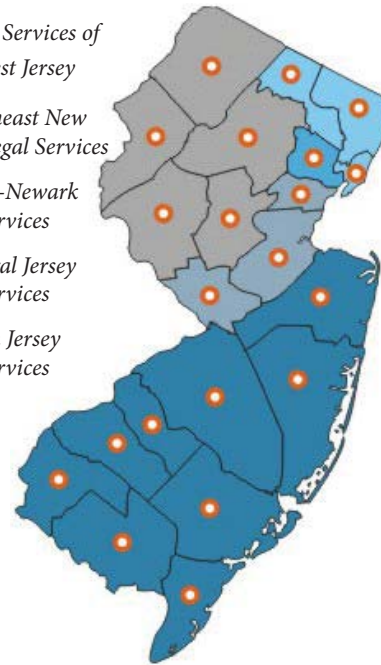

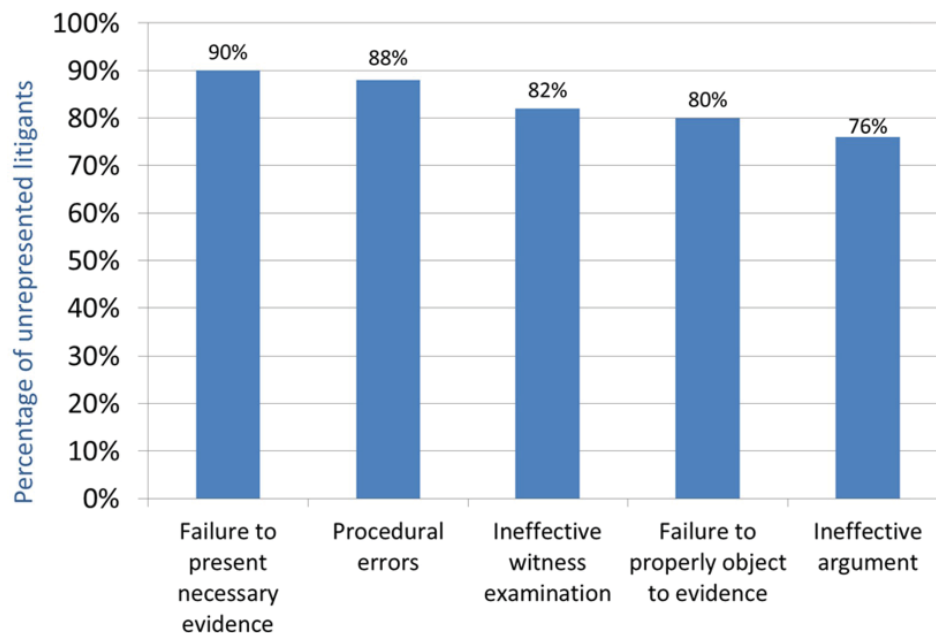

THE STRUGGLE FOR EQUAL JUSTICE

There is no right to an attorney in civil legal cases. Over 2.7 million individuals in New Jersey live in actual poverty. Nearly 40% of them, 767,342, are children and 1,973,500 are adults. The adults will face over 1.18 million civil legal problems during the year. They will be able to secure needed legal representation for less than 6% of these problems.

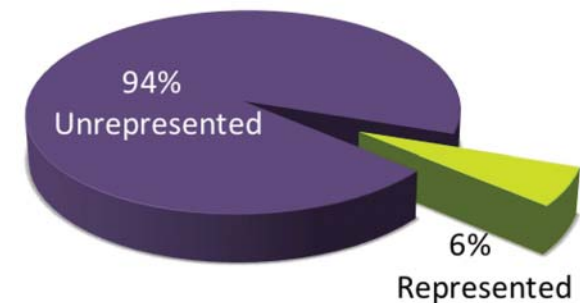
Consequences of Not Having an Attorney

Without proper legal representation, many are forced to represent themselves in court, making them vulnerable to errors that can cost them money, their homes, their livelihood. A 2010 survey of 1,000 trial judges illustrates the weakness inherent in people representing themselves in court.
